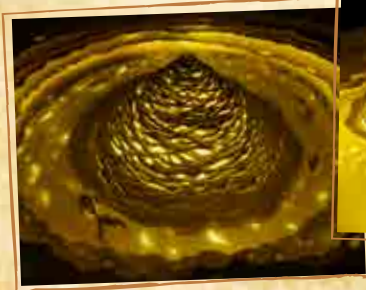
Hari & Deepti are a husband-wife artist duo based in Mumbai, who bring their stories to life through their intricate paper cut light boxes.

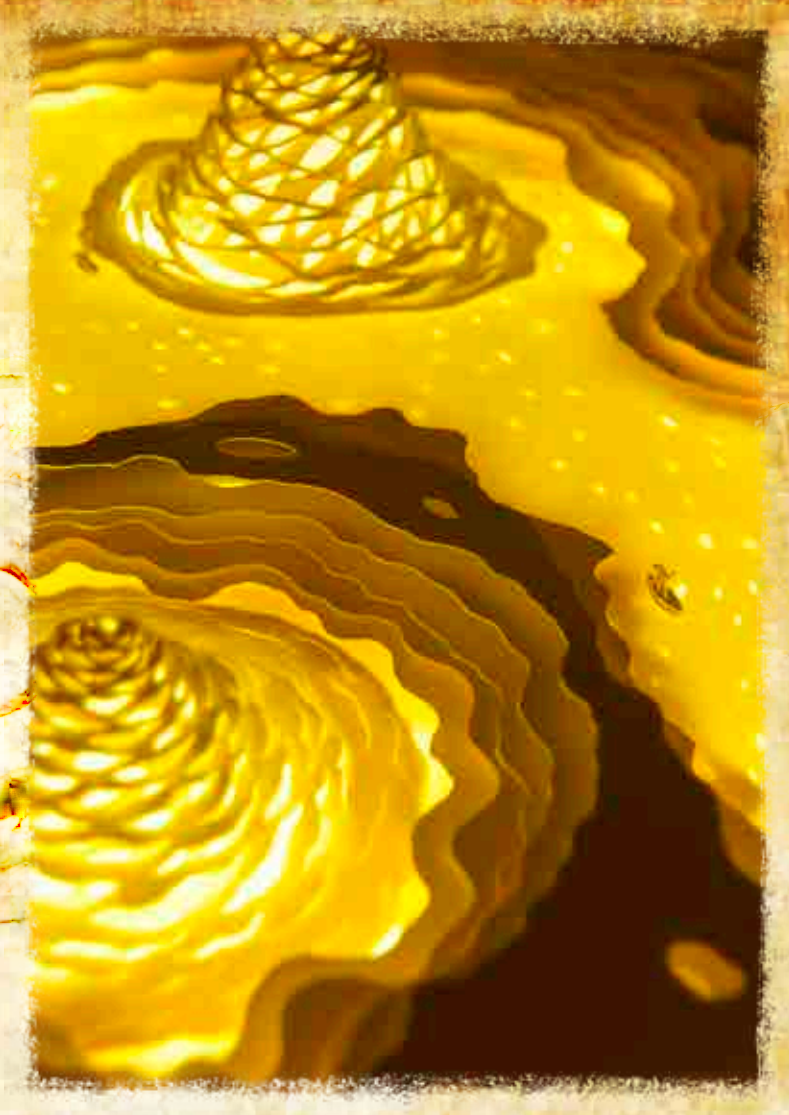
Their installation titled - Foxfire will create an environment inspired by a quote by John Muir
